Bristol Fashion ready for Barbershop Convention

Bristol Fashion, a multi-award winning ladies choir from Bristol, will hold its final rehearsal on Thursday (13th October) before setting off to Harrogate to perform in a national singing competition.

The 51-strong chorus, which sings four part harmony a cappella, is one of 20 choirs from across the country which will compete at the Ladies Association of British Barbershop Singers Convention in Harrogate on Saturday 22nd October.

Led by its musical director Craig Kehoe, the chorus will perform the ballad The Sunshine of Your Smile and the up-tempo You Turned The Tables On Me.

Craig Kehoe says: "The Convention weekend is the highlight of our year. We have worked extremely hard on our competition package over recent months, with extra rehearsal nights and weekend coaching, and we're now ready to take it to the big stage in Harrogate.

"We've done very well at the last two Conventions, moving up into Division One last year. Our aim this year is to break into the ranks of the top ten."

Yesterday, the chorus performed its Convention package before a packed audience at the Colston Hall, as part of the Rotary Club of Bristol's 49th charity concert.
